COOL TOLERANT PLANTS BELONG OUTSIDE NOW, THEY CAN HANDLE COLD NIGHTS

LEAFY GREENS

Lettuce, Kale, Swiss Chard, Mustard Greens

BRASSICA FAMILY

Mustards, Arugula, Cabbage, Kohlrabi, Kale,
Brussel Sprouts, radishes

ROOTS & SHOOTS

Peas, Beets, Carrots, Radishes, Turnips,
Onions, Daikon, etc

*Harden
them off
first!*

HEAT LOVERS NEED WARMER NIGHTS: 10 CELSIUS WILL MAINTAIN CIRCADIAN RHYTHMS

Harden them off now

CUCURBITS

This family of plants needs WARM evening temps or they may become injured below 12 degrees Celsius: Cucumbers, Squash, Melons, Zucchini

TOMATOES, PEPPERS & EGGPLANT

Best to wait until night time temps are above 10 degrees, very interesting literature about their circadian rhythms confirm this. Check to see if your greenhouse is keep the heat up through the night. harden them off though by all means, these temps are just around the corner!

BEANS

Do not like to be transplanted, wait to plant these seeds until soil temps are WARM: some say 10 degrees, some say 15 degrees celsius.

Warm Nights are on their way!
