




SLUGS ARE
RAMPAGING



Iron/ferric phosphate slug baits are widely available & are safe and effective.

*NOT LIKE THE OLD METALDEHYDE BAITs THAT WERE DANGEROUS TO BIRDS, & PETS, ETC.

The baits work by attracting slugs to eat the pasta particles and take in the iron, which disrupts a mollusc's ability to make slime. The bait is not a contact poison and doesn't work by toxicity.



*SPRAYING AMMONIA ON SOIL FOR SLUGS IS ILLEGAL & NOT SPECIFIC TO SLUGS



Many local gardeners also swear by placing beer in a tin or cup, above soil surface; slugs go for a sip and drown.

Keep it above to soil to save ground beetles, which eat slugs!
